# 21<sup>st</sup> Century Policing

---

- Task Force on 21<sup>st</sup> Century Policing
  - Established by President on December 18, 2014
  - Final Report released May 18, 2015
- Final Report: 58 Recommendations and 91 Action Items
  - 38 Recommendations Directly Related to Law Enforcement
  - 50 Action Items Directly Related to Law Enforcement
- Recommendations Include
  - Promote Positive Interactions Between Police and Communities
  - Adopt and Use New Technologies to Enhance Public Trust and Public Safety
  - Promote Officer Wellness and Safety

- Six Pillars Created from Task Force Report
  - PILLAR ONE: Building Trust & Legitimacy
  - PILLAR TWO: Policy & Oversight
  - PILLAR THREE: Technology & Social Media
  - PILLAR FOUR: Community Policing & Crime Reduction
  - PILLAR FIVE: Training & Education
  - PILLAR SIX: Officer Wellness & Safety



# 21<sup>st</sup> Century Policing

---

## Pillar 1: Building Trust & Legitimacy

*“Building trust and nurturing legitimacy on both sides of the police/citizen divide is the foundational principle underlying the nature of relations between law enforcement agencies and the communities they serve.”*

- Accomplishments:
  - 7 out of 9 Recommendations
  - 11 out of 12 Action Items
- Needed:
  - Publishing Response to Resistance Statistics
  - Conducting Community Surveys to Solicit Information



# 21<sup>st</sup> Century Policing

---

## Pillar 2: Policy & Oversight

*“If police are to carry out their responsibilities according to established policies, those policies must reflect community values.”*

- Accomplishments:
  - 12 out of 13 Recommendations
  - 6 out of 7 Action Items
- Needed:
  - De-escalation Policy
  - LGBTQ Search and Seizure Policies




# 21<sup>st</sup> Century Policing

## Pillar 3: Technology & Social Media

*“The use of technology can improve policing practices and build community trust and legitimacy, but its implementation must be built on a defined policy framework with its purposes and goals clearly delineated.”*

- Accomplishments:
  - 3 out of 3 Recommendations
  - 5 out of 5 Action Items

## Pillar 4: Community Policing & Crime Reduction

*“Community policing emphasizes working with neighborhood residents to co-produce public safety.”*

- Accomplishments:
  - 4 out of 4 Recommendations
  - 17 out of 17 Action Items

---

## Pillar 5: Training & Education

*“As our nation becomes more pluralistic and the scope of law enforcement’s responsibilities expands, the need for expanded and more effective training has become critical.”*

- Accomplishments:
  - 2 out of 3 Recommendations
  - 1 out of 2 Action Items
- Needed:
  - Community Involvement on Internal Training Committee
  - Arrest Procedure Policies for Transgender Community

## Pillar 6: Officer Wellness & Safety

*“The wellness and safety of law enforcement officers is critical not only for the officers, their colleagues, and their agencies but also to public safety.”*

- Accomplishments:
  - 3 out of 3 Recommendations
  - 3 out of 3 Action Items
