Code Revisions to Chapter 33

Water, Sewers and Sewage Disposal

Background

- Last comprehensive revision occurred in 1983
- Participants included Budget and Finance, Water Services, and the City Attorney's Office

Purpose

- Comply with changes to state and federal law
- Adopt practices commonly employed by other municipalities
- Improve customer service

Code Revisions to Chapter 33

Water, Sewers and Sewage Disposal

Proposed revisions:

- Identifies information to be collected on new customer accounts
- Allows for proration of customer accounts for partial billing periods
- Provides a timeline for final bill disputes
- Uses generic references to the “City” instead of specific job titles
- Consolidates all rates and fees in one location for user convenience

Code Revisions to Chapter 33

Water, Sewers and Sewage Disposal

More substantive proposed revisions:

- Updates provisions for turning on and off services
 - Complies with state law for residential customers
 - Commercial customer balances must be paid prior to the restoration of services to that property
 - Hardships
- Gives staff the discretion to adjust fees and amounts billed
 - Leaks
 - Unexplained usage

Code Revisions to Chapter 33

Water, Sewers and Sewage Disposal

Proposed revisions:

- Clearly identifies unlawful utility activities
 - Meter tampering
 - Unauthorized usage
- Grants the City Manager the authority to implement the drought management plan
- Clarifies responsibilities for sewer blockages and/or damage

Code Revisions to Chapter 2 Administration

Proposed revisions:

- Technical amendments
 - Warehouse personnel and the Materials Manager
 - Corrects use of the term “fund”
- Authorizes staff to settle certain collection accounts
 - Authority could be based on dollar amounts
