

RESOLUTION NO. 4929 NEW SERIES

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF FFY 2013 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM AWARD-REALLOCATION FROM THE STATE OF ARIZONA, ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$19,317 FUNDED UNDER THE URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FOR THE UNIFIED COMMAND SITUATIONAL ROOM SERVER UPDATE ON BEHALF OF THE GLENDALE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Glendale Fire Department previously submitted an application for grant funding to the Arizona Department of Homeland Security (AZDOHS) under the Urban Area Security Initiative in the amount of \$108,000 for training and equipment purchase for the Glendale Fire RRT Program; and

WHEREAS, the original grant was accepted by the Glendale City Council on October 8, 2013 and the expenditure of the grant funds and additional non-reimbursable funds were authorized pursuant to Resolution No. 4729 New Series; and

WHEREAS, the City of Glendale Fire Department submitted an application for reallocated grant funding in December of 2014; and

WHEREAS, in January, 2015 AZDOHS awarded the City of Glendale Fire Department reallocated grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Glendale Fire Department is seeking for Council to authorize the acceptance and expenditure of the reallocated grant funds.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Glendale hereby accepts the FFY Homeland Security Grant Program Award-Reallocation (Subgrantee Agreement No. 130810-04) for the Project entitled "Unified Command Situational Room Server Update" funded under the Urban Area Security Initiative in the approximate amount of \$19,317 on behalf of the Glendale Fire Department.

SECTION 2. That the Council of the City of Glendale hereby authorizes expenditure of these grant funds for the Unified Command Situational Room Server Update project, as more fully set forth in the application for reallocated FFY 2013 Homeland Security Grant Program funds.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary for the acceptance of said grant on behalf of the City of Glendale.
