Glendale, Phoenix, Chandler, and Gilbert have been discussing the proposed Multi-City Single Family Water Use Study over the past year. The project will investigate existing water use and project future changes in water demand and wastewater generation associated with single family homes of different age, size, landscape type, and geographic location.

The participating entities have agreed to move forward with the project, which will be sponsored by a grant from the Arizona Department of Water Resources. Phoenix will administer the study and manage the contract with project consultant Aquacraft.

In conformance with ARS §11-952, the City of Glendale has obtained approval of its City Council to participate in this study with the other municipalities by providing in-kind services such as staff time for the duration of the project. I have enclosed the Council's recent Resolution, which demonstrates our commitment to this endeavor, for your information.

We look forward to working with our regional partners to better understand the Valley's current water usage and predict its future water demand.
